Purple Light Taoist Studies Program



Purple Light Program was established as a dedicated Taoist studies program in the West for those who are interested in pursuing either a career path or a personal path of study. Led by Master teachers the program will guide students in a 3 year program of committed study, beginning with the basics of Taoist Self Cultivation practices and leading toward mastery of Taoist Healing, Teaching and Devotional Arts.

A part of the White Cloud Institute in Santa Fe, New Mexico, Purple Light will strengthen the pure alchemical and conscious evolutionary practices using Ancient Taoist modalities as a bridge to connect all lineages, and bring ancient teachings into present day situations. As the earth moves through her evolution, lineage traditions must come forward to clarify and share their understanding of the human experience. White Cloud Institute embraces all lineage and wisdom traditions, while honoring the specific treasures offered by the Taoist tradition.



This 3 year program is dedicated specifically to teaching the spiritual aspects of Taoist healing, philosophy and meditation practices which contribute to the harmonious evolution of earth and all beings.

COURSE OF STUDY: Classes will meet in Santa Fe. In addition, students may attend monthly weekend courses taught by visiting Taoist Masters. Students are required to attend all classes, complete written assignments, and participate in classroom discussion of assigned reading. Written and practical exams will be given each semester. Homework and practice time outside of class will be necessary.

YEAR ONE: SELF-CULTIVATION PRACTICES, TAOIST THEORY & PHILOSOPHY, FALL SEMESTER BEGINS SEPTEMBER 10, 2008. WEDNESDAY EVENINGS 5:30-8:30PM \$900 PER SEMESTER. 12 WEEKS EACH SEMESTER.

Students will learn to purify and cultivate a pure river of chi for their own healing and develop a deeper understanding of the harmonization of energies within the body and the universe. Studies will include the classics; I Ching, Tao te Ching and Qigong and Meditation Practices for self healing and purification.

YEAR TWO: CULTIVATING VIRTUE AND EXTERNAL CHI HEALING. 150 HOUR PROGRAM, 6, 3 DAY WEEKENDS BEGINS SEPTEMBER 2008 (PREREQUISITE IS COMPLETION OF YEAR ONE, OR INSTRUCTOR'S APPROVAL) \$2,500 FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR COURSE.

In Year two students will learn to project a highly refined quality of chi for healing through their continued study and practice of Qigong, Meditation and Chi Nei Tsang. Year 2 Training also includes: Theory of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Taoist Energy Healing Techniques and Diagnosis, Developing Intuitive Healing Abilities and hands on practice in Clinic.

YEAR THREE: INITIATION INTO SHAMANIC HEALING AND TEMPLE PRACTICES SEPTEMBER 2009

Students will personalize their program with the guidance of the instructors of the Purple Light Program. Students may elect to follow a path of specialization into either the Healing Arts or the Philosophical, Teaching or Devotional Arts. including temple practice, healing, teaching, pilgrimage and star practices.

DIRECTOR, Caryn Boyd Diel, the founder of White Cloud Institute, has a full time healing practice in Santa Fe, NM. She incorporates a lifetime of study in the areas of counseling, bodywork and hands on healing. Her training has taken her around the world. Caryn has a Masters degree in Education and Counseling from the University of California. She graduated from the Barbara Brennan School of Healing, studied Medical Qigong at the Xi Yuan Hospital in Beijing, China and at the International Institute of Medical Qigong with Sifu J.A. Johnson. She is a Full Instructor with the Universal Healing Tao and has studied with M.Chia in Thailand.

Weekend Seminars with visiting Instructors:

Livia Kohn is Professor of Religion and East Asian Studies at Boston University. She has spent many years pursuing research on medieval Taoism and Chinese long life practices. She has written and edited numerous books, practiced Taiji quan, Qigong and meditation for over twenty years. She is also fluent in 4 languages.

Master Zhongxian Wu Master Wu is the recognized master of multiple lineages of classical Qigong, Taiji and martial Arts. He will be teaching Calligraphy and Shamanic Qigong. Currently he is teaching at NCNM in Portland. He has instructed thousands of students and authored numerous articles. Master Wu is a sub investigator for the NIH research into the effects of Qigong and health.
